# Report on Students Participation in Intercollegiate Sports Meet of

#### Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Gwalior

#### **Overview**

This report provides a brief analysis of students' participation from the College of Agriculture (Indore, Gwalior, Khandwa, Sehore) and the College of Horticulture (Mandsaur) in the intercollegiate sports meets organized by Rajmata Vijayaraje Scindia Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya from 2019-20 to 2023-24. The report excludes the COVID-19 pandemic years of 2020-21 and 2021-22 as no event could take place during the COVID-19 hit days. The intercollegiate sports meets serve as a platform for promoting athletic talent, teamwork, and the spirit of competition among students, contributing significantly to their overall development.

The intercollegiate sports meets featured a diverse range of indoor and outdoor events, providing opportunities for students to showcase their skills. Events included:

# RULES AND REGULATION FOR INTER COLLEGIATE INTER, UNVERSITY TOURNAMENT

#### 1. ORGANISATION AND CONSITUTION:-

To ensure that the Inter Collegiate / Inter University sports activities are conducted efficiently and are organized under the general direction of the RVSKVV and in conformity with its policies a Sports and Games organization committee has been constituted for each colleges as follows:-

- (a) Chairman Concerned Dean
- (b) Secretary Concerned Sports Officer
- (C) Member 8 (Eight) Maximum Concerned Colleges.

Members at (C) will be nominated by chairmen and shall be persons who possess knowledge of technical matters.

- 1. For the purpose of efficient running of the Inter Collegiate / Inter University tournaments and their effective technical supervision & selection of V.V. teams, University sports committee has been constituted and this committee shall be an organ of the RVSKVV. The construction of university sports committee as follows:-
- (a) Chairman University Sports Officer
- (b) Member -03 (Three)

Member at (b) will be nominated by the chairman with consultation of the concerned college Dean, and shall be persons who are the experts of the related games & sports.

2. No entrée fee shall be charged for any game or tournament organized by the V.V.

#### II. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES :-

The Principle objectives of the tournaments shall be :-

- (a) To participate in Inter Collegiate & Inter University tournaments.
- (b) To encourage sportsmanship generally and to promote friendly relation among constituent colleges.
- (c) To raise the standard of Sports and Games prevailing in the colleges and to work for the development of character values through sports amongst the university students.
- (d) To organize coaching camps on regional and national basis.
- (e) To encourage such other activities as may be conducive to the aims & objects of the sports and games.

#### III. TOURNAMENTS:-

The following tournaments shall be ordinarily be organized by the V.V.

#### **FOR MEN:**-

Athletics, Badminton, T.T., Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Volley ball, Carram.

#### **FOR WOMEN:-**

Athletics, Badminton, T.T. & Carram.

The tournaments in the various games shall be played on Knock out basis.

#### IV. ENTRESS AND VENUES :-

- i. Each constituent college shall be entitled to enter only one team for each Tournament / Competition.
- ii. The organizing college will be invited the entrees of the concerned tournament at least 15 days before the commencement of the competition.
- iii. The organizing Secretary shall communicate the names of the entering colleges to the Office of the D.S.W. after the last date of receipt of the entries of the tournaments.

#### V. (a) ELIGIBILITY :-

- i. No students shall be eligible to participate in any of the Inter Collegiate / Interuniversity Tournaments if he/she has completed the age of 27 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> July of that academic year.
- ii. Those students who have completed course programme and going to RAWE/FAWE/ Internship are eligible to participate.
- iii. B.S.c.(Ag) / B.S.c.(Hort.) final year summer course out going students are not be eligible to participate.
- iv. Eligibility rules will be applicable as per Inter university and **Sharirik Shiksha Avam Krida Margadrshika.** Written by Dr. V.S. Sengar University Sports Officer, RVSKVV, Gwalior.

#### (b) Disqualification for violation of Eligibility Rules:-

- i. Any disqualification of a player on ground of ineligibility will result in the automatic scratching of the team for that academic year. The team shall also be debarred from participating in the tournament ( in that game) to be held in the following year.
- ii. A player disqualified on the grounds of ineligibility shall not be permitted to participated in University Tournament in the next year.
- iii. Team Manager/ Coach will be equally responsible for disqualification of a Player on grounds of ineligibility.

#### VI. DATES AND DRAWS:-

The organizing colleges shall run their respective tournaments in accordance with the schedule indicated in the sports calendar. Any subsequent changes in the dates shall not be made without the prior approval of the chairman of the V.V. sports committee. Draws shall be made by lots at V.V. level.

#### VII. TROPHIES AND CERTIFICATES:-

- i. All the Trophies of the Inter Collegiate Tournaments shall be running trophies.
- ii. The Trophies shall be the property of the University. The colleges, receiving running trophies awarded at final matches shall hold themselves and responsible for the safety and care of the trophies they receive.
- iii. The colleges holding any of the trophies to send it at its own cost to the university before organizing the tournaments of the next year.
- iv. In team games certificates of merit signed by the Dean. Dean Students Welfare, University Sports Officer & organizing Secretary shall be awarded only to the winners and runners-up of the Inter Collegiate Tournament. In Individual games like Athletics, Merit certificates shall be awarded up to 3<sup>rd</sup> position holder. In case of athletics special championship certificates shall be awarded on the basis of the highest points obtained by the individual, in the sports concerned.

#### VIII. GENERAL RULES :-

- (a) Each playing member of the team participating in the Inter University Inter collegiate tournaments shall carry Identity card which shall bear the following:-
- i. Photograph of the player and his / her signature.
- ii. Attestation by the D.S.W./Dean/Sport Officer concerned, under seal. The signature of the attesting authority must be on the photograph.
- (b) A team not carrying identity cards, as defined in the rules, shall not be allowed to participate in the tournament concerned. Any identity card bearing unauthorized over-writing shall not be accepted valid by the organizing committee. The over-writing, if any, must be initialed by the appropriate authority as referred to in rule No. VIII subsection (a) II.
- (c) To maintained the discipline and status of the teams the Coach/Manager will be appointed among the teachers who are the experts of the concerned Games & Sports or Sports officer equivalent to the teachers. The Team Manager/Coach shall not be below than the teacher or sports officer who is equivalent to the Teacher. It should be followed strictly.

**IX.** <u>Colours:</u> All colleges teams shall participate in the Inter University /Inter Collegiate tournaments in their respective colours.

#### X. Umpires: their selection and powers:-

a. The organizing college shall be responsible for selecting competent umpires whose decision on all points of fact shall be final and binding. The panel of umpires / refries shall be drawing up by the organizing college well in advance.

#### b. Expenses of Umpires:-

Expenses incurred on umpiring shall be borne by the organizing college.

#### XI. PROTESTS:-

- a. Protests against the decision of an umpire on a point of rule and any other protest in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the organizing secretary within one hours of the conclusion of the concerned games & sports.
- b. A protest fees of Rs. 500 shall accompany avert protest. The protest fee shall be forfeited whenever a protest not sustained. In such cases the protest fee shall be remitted to the organizing college. Any team leaving the field of play under protest shall be deemed to have lost the fixtures and forfeited its right to protest.
- c. No member, including an official of a participating team shall interfere with the conduct of a tournament of any match of the tournament and shall not enter into argument with the supervising official or the organizing officials, nor shall they question the judgment of the umpire (s) referee (s) / Judge (s) etc.
- d. The Participating colleges shall supply copies of the eligibility particulars of the members of their teams, on the prescribed proforma complete in all respect to the organizing secretary in duplicate. The teams also bring their college flag with them.
- e. The team will required to report on the ground at least 30 minutes before the scheduled of the match in proper uniform.
- f. The team will intimate its journey scheduled by fax to the organizing college.
- g. First aid and Medical assistance will be provided on the play ground. In case of major injuries the cost of medical treatment if any shall be born by the manager of the team concerned.
- h. Dean of organizing colleges will make all necessary arrangements for the tournament.
- i. Accommodation to the team will be provided at university campus/ organizing college's campus. Each member of the team must bring his own mosquite net and beddings, locks and keys etc.

#### XII. RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF GAMES :-

#### 1. ATHLETICS (M/W)

i. The competition will be conducted under the International Athletic federation rules as adopted by the Amateur Athletic federation of India.

#### ii. (a) Events for men.

Relay Race 4 x 100 meters

Races 100, 200, 400, 800 & 1500 meters

Jumps Long & High

Throws Shot-put, Javelin & Discus

#### (b) Events for women.

Relay Race 4 x 100 meters

Races 100, 200, 400, 800 & 1500 meters

Jumps Long & High

Throws Shot-put, Discus and Javelin

- ❖ An athlete can participate in maximum Three Events excluding relay.
- iii. The order of events shall be fixed and notified in advance to all the participants colleges. The competition may continue for two consecutive days.
- iv. <u>Points & certificates</u>:- Points shall be awarded on team basis in each event excluding relay races the Athlete shall score for the first place five points, the second place three points and the third place one point. In the relay races the first place team scores 10, the second place team college 6 and the third place team 2 points. The merit certification shall be awarded only up to 3<sup>rd</sup> position.
- v. <u>Championship</u>: The College scoring the total highest number of points shall be declaring as the champion of University for the year. In case of a tie for the championship, the university which has the greater number of first places to its credits shall be adjudged as the champion.

#### 2. BADMINTON (M/W)

- 1. The competition shall be conducted under International Badminton federation rules as adopted by the Badminton Association of India.
- 2. The tournament for men & women sections will be conducted on the lines given as below:-

Men & Women = 2 Singles and doubles in the following order : Singles AV/SY, Doubles and BV/SX.

- 3. Yonex AS-2 shuttle cock will be used.
- 4. The tie for (m/w) matches shall be decided by the combined results of 2 singles & one double. The result of a tie, however, can be declared when either of the competing teams wins two matches for man / women section.

5. The order of the events shall be as follow:-

Men & Women First Singles Second Doubles Singles

6. The number of players representing a college in a team shall be 4 for men and women teams.

#### 3. CARRAM (M/W)

- 1. The matches will be decided on the basis of best of three, first two singles, if needed then finally doubles. Individual matches will be decided on the best of 29 points or 11 boards whichever occurs first.
- 2. The number of players represents a colleges shall be 4 in each team of men / women section.

#### 4. TABLETENNIS (M/W)

- 1. The latest International rules of the International T.T. Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India shall apply.
- 2. The number of players representing a college shall be 4 in each team of men/ women section.
- 3. The matches will be decided on the basis of best of five consisting of 5 singles.

#### 5. KABADDI(M)

- 1. The tournament will be run in accordance with the rules of the Kabaddi Federation of India.
- 2. A Team shall consist of 12 players in Inter Collegiate Tournaments.
- 3. The participants should have proper number printed on both side on their Jersey/vest.
- 4. The weight of the participants should be maximum of 80 kg for Men and 70 kg. for Women.

#### 6. <u>KHO-KHO ( M )</u>

- 1. The rules as adopted by the Kho-Kho Federation of India shall apply to the Inter collegiate tournaments.
- 2. A Team shall consist of maximum number of 12 players in Inter Collegiate Tournaments.
- 3. The participants should have proper number printed on both side on their Jersey/ Vest.

#### 7. **VOLLEY BALL (M)**

- The International rules as adopted by the Volley ball Federation of India shall be followed. However all the matches except the finals will be decided on best of three sets.
- 2. A team consists of 12 players in Inter collegiate tournament.
- 3. The participants should have proper number printed on both sides of their Jersey/ Vest.

**Note** Organizing committee has reserve the right to change the fixture if it seems necessary and every team has to bound to follow the same. The decision of the technical committee/organizing committee shall be final and binding in all matters related to the competition.



- (c) To raise the standard of Sports and Games prevailing in the colleges and to work for the development of character values through sports amongst the university students.
- (d) To organize coaching camps on regional and national basis.
- (e) To encourage such other activities as may be conducive to the aims & objects of the sports and games.

#### III. TOURNAMENTS:-

The following tournaments shall be ordinarily be organized by the V.V.

#### FOR MEN:-

Athletics, Badminton, T.T., Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Volley ball, Carram.

#### **FOR WOMEN:-**

Athletics, Badminton, T.T. & Carram.

The tournaments in the various games shall be played on Knock out basis.

#### IV. ENTRESS AND VENUES :-

- i. Each constituent college shall be entitled to enter only one team for each Tournament / Competition.
- ii. The organizing college will be invited the entrees of the concerned tournament at least 15 days before the commencement of the competition.
- iii. The organizing Secretary shall communicate the names of the entering colleges to the Office of the D.S.W. after the last date of receipt of the entries of the tournaments.

#### V. (a) ELIGIBILITY :-

- i. No students shall be eligible to participate in any of the Inter Collegiate / Interuniversity Tournaments if he/she has completed the age of 25 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> July of that academic year.
- ii. Those students who have completed course programme and going to RAWE/FAWE/ Internship are eligible to participate.
- iii. B.S.c.(Ag) / B.S.c.(Hort.) final year summer course out going students are not be eligible to participate.
- iv. Eligibility rules will be applicable as per Inter university and **Sharirik Shiksha Avam Krida Margadrshika.** Written by Dr. V.S. Sengar University Sports Officer, RVSKVV, Gwalior.

#### (b) Disqualification for violation of Eligibility Rules:-

- i. Any disqualification of a player on ground of ineligibility will result in the automatic scratching of the team for that academic year. The team shall also be debarred from participating in the tournament ( in that game) to be held in the following year.
- ii. A player disqualified on the grounds of ineligibility shall not be permitted to participated in University Tournament in the next year.
- iii. Team Manager/ Coach will be equally responsible for disqualification of a Player on grounds of ineligibility.

#### VI. DATES AND DRAWS:-

The organizing colleges shall run their respective tournaments in accordance with the schedule indicated in the sports calendar. Any subsequent changes in the dates shall not be made without the prior approval of the chairman of the V.V. sports committee. Draws shall be made by lots at V.V. level.

#### VII. TROPHIES AND CERTIFICATES:-

- i. All the Trophies of the Inter Collegiate Tournaments shall be running trophies.
- ii. The Trophies shall be the property of the University. The colleges, receiving running trophies awarded at final matches shall hold themselves and responsible for the safety and care of the trophies they receive.
- iii. The colleges holding any of the trophies to send it at its own cost to the university before organizing the tournaments of the next year.
- iv. In team games certificates of merit signed by the Dean. Dean Students Welfare, University Sports Officer & organizing Secretary shall be awarded only to the winners and runners-up of the Inter Collegiate Tournament. In Individual games like Athletics, Merit certificates shall be awarded up to 3<sup>rd</sup> position holder. In case of athletics special championship certificates shall be awarded on the basis of the highest points obtained by the individual, in the sports concerned.

#### VIII. GENERAL RULES :-

- (a) Each playing member of the team participating in the Inter University Inter collegiate tournaments shall carry Identity card which shall bear the following:-
- i. Photograph of the player and his / her signature.
- ii. Attestation by the D.S.W./Dean/Sport Officer concerned, under seal. The signature of the attesting authority must be on the photograph.
- (b) A team not carrying identity cards, as defined in the rules, shall not be allowed to participate in the tournament concerned. Any identity card bearing unauthorized over-writing shall not be accepted valid by the organizing committee. The over-writing, if any, must be initialed by the appropriate authority as referred to in rule No. VIII subsection (a) II.
- (c) To maintained the discipline and status of the teams the Coach/Manager will be appointed among the teachers who are the experts of the concerned Games & Sports or Sports officer equivalent to the teachers. The Team Manager/Coach shall not be below than the teacher or sports officer who is equivalent to the Teacher. It should be followed strictly.

**IX.** <u>Colours:</u> All colleges teams shall participate in the Inter University /Inter Collegiate tournaments in their respective colours.

#### X. Umpires: their selection and powers:-

a. The organizing college shall be responsible for selecting competent umpires whose decision on all points of fact shall be final and binding. The panel of umpires / refries shall be drawing up by the organizing college well in advance.

#### b. Expenses of Umpires:-

Expenses incurred on umpiring shall be borne by the organizing college.

#### XI. PROTESTS:-

- a. Protests against the decision of an umpire on a point of rule and any other protest in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the organizing secretary within one hours of the conclusion of the concerned games & sports.
- b. A protest fees of Rs. 500 shall accompany avert protest. The protest fee shall be forfeited whenever a protest not sustained. In such cases the protest fee shall be remitted to the organizing college. Any team leaving the field of play under protest shall be deemed to have lost the fixtures and forfeited its right to protest.
- c. No member, including an official of a participating team shall interfere with the conduct of a tournament of any match of the tournament and shall not enter into argument with the supervising official or the organizing officials, nor shall they question the judgment of the umpire (s) referee (s) / Judge (s) etc.
- d. The Participating colleges shall supply copies of the eligibility particulars of the members of their teams, on the prescribed proforma complete in all respect to the organizing secretary in duplicate. The teams also bring their college flag with them.
- e. The team will required to report on the ground at least 30 minutes before the scheduled of the match in proper uniform.
- f. The team will intimate its journey scheduled by fax to the organizing college.
- g. First aid and Medical assistance will be provided on the play ground. In case of major injuries the cost of medical treatment if any shall be born by the manager of the team concerned.
- h. Dean of organizing colleges will make all necessary arrangements for the tournament.
- i. Accommodation to the team will be provided at university campus/ organizing college's campus. Each member of the team must bring his own mosquite net and beddings, locks and keys etc.

- v. <u>Championship</u>: The College scoring the total highest number of points shall be declaring as the champion of University for the year. In case of a tie for the championship, the university which has the greater number of first places to its credits shall be adjudged as the champion.

#### 2. BADMINTON(M/W)

- 1. The competition shall be conducted under International Badminton federation rules as adopted by the Badminton Association of India.
- 2. The tournament for men & women sections will be conducted on the lines given as below:

Men & Women = 2 Singles and doubles in the following order:

Singles AV/SY, Doubles and BV/SX.

- 3. Yonex AS-2 shuttle cock will be used.
- 4. The tie for (m/w) matches shall be decided by the combined results of 2 singles & one double. The result of a tie, however, can be declared when either of the competing teams wins two matches for man / women section.

5. The order of the events shall be as follow:-

Men & Women First Singles Second Doubles Singles

6. The number of players representing a college in a team shall be 4 for men and women teams.

#### 3. CARRAM (M/W)

- 1. The matches will be decided on the basis of best of three, first two singles, if needed then finally doubles. Individual matches will be decided on the best of 29 points or 11 boards whichever occurs first.
- 2. The number of players represents a colleges shall be 4 in each team of men / women section.

#### 4. TABLETENNIS (M/W)

- 1. The latest International rules of the International T.T. Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India shall apply.
- 2. The number of players representing a college shall be 4 in each team of men/ women section.
- 3. The matches will be decided on the basis of best of five consisting of 5 singles.

#### 5. KABADDI(M)

- 1. The tournament will be run in accordance with the rules of the Kabaddi Federation of India.
- 2. A Team shall consist of 12 players in Inter Collegiate Tournaments.
- 3. The participants should have proper number printed on both side on their Jersey/vest.
- 4. The weight of the participants should be maximum of 80 kg for Men and 70 kg. for Women.

#### 6. $\underline{\text{KHO-KHO}(M)}$

- 1. The rules as adopted by the Kho-Kho Federation of India shall apply to the Inter collegiate tournaments.
- 2. A Team shall consist of maximum number of 12 players in Inter Collegiate Tournaments.
- 3. The participants should have proper number printed on both side on their Jersey/ Vest.

#### 7. **VOLLEY BALL (M)**

- The International rules as adopted by the Volley ball Federation of India shall be followed. However all the matches except the finals will be decided on best of three sets.
- 2. A team consists of 12 players in Inter collegiate tournament.
- 3. The participants should have proper number printed on both sides of their Jersey/ Vest.

**Note** Organizing committee has reserve the right to change the fixture if it seems necessary and every team has to bound to follow the same. The decision of the technical committee/organizing committee shall be final and binding in all matters related to the competition.



# **DEAN STUDENTS WELFARE**

#### **Guidelines to follow:**

- The College team will participate in all the events listed in Annexure. With the condition that the entries are exceptionally good.
- The maximum number of participants which will be 25.
- The maximum number 25 participants that will make up the college team including managers and accompanist.
- Each- contingent should be accompanied by 2 staff members. In case of female participants, a female member should accompany the team.
- The age of participating student should not be more than twenty five years on the scheduled date of competitions.
- Student pursuing bridge course or doing part time course shall not be eligible to participate in the V.V. Youth festival.
- Student must be advised to conduct themselves in an orderly manner.
- The decision of Judges will be final.
- The mangers are requested to submit the proforma duly completed in all respect, valid ID card of participants and college flag at the first day of Inter-Collegiate Cultural competition.
- The decision of the organizing committee shall be final and binding in all the matters pertaining to the conduct of the Inter-Agri-Competition.
- Use of fire is prohibited.
- Any type of damage to stage or mike is to be bear by the concerning college.
- Dean of college are requested to confirm their participation well in advance to Dean
  of organizing college and also to the undersigned.
- During the formulation of the culture team to represent at the National level the openion of the judges on the individual artist performance at the university level competition may be given due consideration.

#### REGULATIONS FOR YOUTH FESTIVAL EVENTS

#### 1. MUSIC

#### 1. PATRIOTIC SONG:

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Maximum number of singers in a group shall be six.
- Maximum number of accompanists per group shall be three.
- Patriotic songs should be of India origin and can be of any regional language.
- No film songs shall be presented as patriotic songs.
- Maximum time allowed per team is six minutes. Which does not include setting time. The setting per team not exceed four minutes.
- Judging of this item shall be on the basis of quality of singing only and not on the costumes, make up and actions of the team.

#### 2. LIGHT VOCAL (INDIAN):

- Only one participant per team is allowed.
- The number of accompanists shall not be more than two.
- Duration of the song shall be not less than 3 minutes and not more than 6 minutes.
- Only non-film Songs/ Geet/ Ghazal/ Bhajan/ Shabad/ Abhangas can be presented.
- Judgment will be made on the qualities like melody tal, Composition and general impression, etc.

#### 3. GROUP SONG (INDIAN):

- Only one participant team per college is allowed.
- The maximum number of singers in a group shall be six.
- The maximum number of accompanists in group playing instruments shall be three.
- Group song shall be other than patriotic songs.
- Two Group songs shall be presented by the same team out of which one will compulsorily be a folk song.
- The group songs should be of Indian origin which can be of any regional language.
- Film songs shall not be presented as group songs.
- Maximum time allowed for the group songs is 10 minutes which does not include setting time. The setting time for a group shall not exceed four minutes.
- Judgment shall be based on the quality of singing only and not on the make up, costumes and action of the team.

#### 2. DANCE

#### 4. GROUP DANCE (FOLK):

- Maximum number of participants per team is ten. The team may consists of all boys, all girls or a mixture of both.
- Maximum number of accompanists is three.
- Duration of Group Dance shall not be more than 10 minutes.
- Participating team shall be responsible for removal of their sets, stage props and properties, etc. immediately after the completion of their performance.
- Three copies of a brief note (in English/Hindi) giving the team and the summary of the song (if any) shall be submitted to the organizing secretary along with the entry form at the time of registration.

### 3. LITERARY

### 5. **QUIZ**:

- Only one team per college is allowed. Each team shall consist of two participants.
- Three shall be a written preliminary round and team will be selected for the final round.
- Finals shall consist of both oral and audio-visual Questions.
- Specific rules regarding time to reply to a question, type of rounds, evaluation procedure shall be framed by the organizing college and, be announced well before the actual start of the quiz competition.

### 6. ELOCUTION:

- Each college shall be represented by one participant.
- Medium of expression shall be English or Hindi.
- Each speaker shall be allowed to speak for maximum of five minutes.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like subject coverage, language, diction and general impression.

#### 7. DEBATE:

- Each team have two participants, one will speak "for" while the another will speak "against" the proposition.
- Medium of the expression shall be English or Hindi.
- Topic of the debate shall be announced 24 hours in advance.
- Each debator shall be allowed to speak for a maximum of 5 minutes.
- Any form of written matter as aid shall not be allowed. Violation shall be liable for disqualification.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like subject, coverage, language, diction and general impression.

### 8. EXTEMPORE SPEECH:

- Each college shall be represented by one participant.
- Topic for extempore shall be put in a "fish pond" from which the participant shall pick.
- Each participants shall be given two minutes for preparation after picking up the topic and maximum of five minutes for presentation.
- Medium of expression shall be English or Hindi.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like subject coverage, diction and general impression.

### 4. THEATRE

### 9. ONE ACT PLAY:

- Only one entry per College will be allowed.
- Plays with themes related, to rural/ agricultural backgrounds only are admitted.
- The duration of the play should not exceed 30 minutes.
- Time shall be counted as soon as he/she "Start" signal is given or the team starts giving the introduction, whichever is earlier.
- For stage setting and removal of set and properties etc, upto 10 minutes in total shall be given after taking charge of the stage.
- Empty stage-to-empty stage shall be strictly followed.
- Maximum number of participants shall be nine and accompanists shall not exceed three.
- The play may be in English, Hindi or any regional language of India, If
  the play is in a regional language, three copies of the synopsis of the
  play in English of Hindi must be submitted to the Organizing Secretary
  on the day of registration.

- Participating teams shall bring their own sets, stage props makeup materials, etc, Lights and general stage property shall be provided by the Host College/ University. Special light and sound effects (if any) shall be arranged by the participating teams.
- Participating team shall report of the official-in-charge of the competition at least two hours before the presentation of the play.
- Judgment will be based on the qualities like theme, acting, stage craft, design and general impression.
- Decision of the judge shall be final and binding upon all.

### 10. SKIT:

- Only one team per College will be allowed.
- Maximum number of participants shall be six and accompanists shall be three.
- Maximum time allotted for each team shall be 10 minutes.
- Language of presentation can be in English, Hindi of any regional language of India.
- Each team shall give three copies of the synopsis in (English/Hindi) of the skit on the day of registration.
- Use of makeup, drapery and background recorded music is allowed.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like theme, acting, stage, craft, design and general impression.

#### 11. MIME:

- Only one entry per College is allowed.
- Maximum number of participants shall be six and accompanists shall be two only.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like idea, creativity of presentation, use of make up, music and general impression.

### 12. MONO-ACTING:

- Each College shall be represented by one participant.
- The theme for mono-acting shall be communicated by he Organizing,
   College well in advance.
- Duration shall not exceed 5 minutes.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like creativity of presentation, use of make up and general impression.

### 5. FINE ARTS

#### 13. ON THE SPOT PAINTING:

- Each College shall be represented by one participant.
- Theme for the competition shall be announced on the spot before the commencement of the competition.
- Duration shall not exceed 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Painting can be done in oil, Water, poster or pastel colours.
- Only drawing sheet will be provided by the Host College
- Participants are to bring their own materials like brushes, Paints, etc.

#### 14. COLLAGE:

- Each College shall be represented by one participant.
- Theme for the college shall be announced on the spot before the commencement of the event.
- College to be done on the spot chosen by the Organizing College.
- Duration shall not exceed 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- A 2 cm border shall be maintained on all sides.
- Only drawing sheet will be provided by the Organizing College.
- Participants shall bring their own scissors, pasting material and glue,
   etc.

#### 15. POSTER MAKING:

- Each College shall be represented by one participant.
- Theme for the college shall be announced on the spot before the commencement of the event.
- Item shall be conducted on the spot chosen by the Organizing College.
- Duration shall not be more than 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- A 2 cm border shall be maintained on all sides.
- Only a drawing sheet, old magazines, colour paper shall be provided by Organizing College/University.
- Participants shall bring own scissors and glue required.
- Duration shall not exceed 2 hrs and 30 minutes.

### 16. CLAY MODELING:

- Each college shall be represented by one participant.
- Theme for the college shall be announced on the spot before the commencement of the event.
- Item shall be done on the spot chosen by the Organizing College.
- Only clay will be provided by the Organizing College.
- Participants shall bring other required materials.
- Duration shall not exceed 2 hours and 30 minutes.

#### 17. CARTOONING:

- Each college shall be represented by one participant.
- Subject shall be announced on the spot before the commencement of the events.
- Item shall be conducted on the spot chosen by the Organizing College.
- Only drawing sheet shall be provided by the Host College.
- Participant shall bring their own other required materials.
- Only one cartoon per sheet is admitted.
- The cartoon shall be in black and white only.
- Duration shall not exceed 2 hours and 30 minutes.

### 18. RANGOLI:

- This art is known differently in various regions as Mandana, Alpana,
   Alekhan, Kolam, Rangoli etc.
- Each college shall be represented by one participant.
- It shall be conducted on the spot chosen by the organizing College.
- Medium and form for expression can be free hand, pictorial, descriptive.
- Coloured powder, flower petals, grains and seeds can be used.
- Duration shall not exceed 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Size of the Rangoli shall be maximum of 2.5 x 2.5 feet.
- Judgment shall be based on intricacy, colour combination, complexity and not based on the theme.
